The Bolney Wine Estate story began in 1972, when owners Janet and Rodney Pratt planted three acres of vines to create what was then only the sixth commercial vineyard in England. Sam Linter, Rodney and Janet's daughter, took over the reins in the mid-1990s. Today, Bolney Wine Estate has grown to 39 acres with a state-of-the-art winery added in 2005. In 2012, Bolney Wine Estate won UK Wine Producer of the Year

### 8. Sparkling Blanc de Blancs ~ England

A very stylish vintage, traditional method, quality sparkling wine. Gentle fruit and lovely length. The hand-picked Chardonnay is whole-bunch pressed and fermented in stainless steel.

### 8a. Sparkling Cuvée Rosé ~ England

100% Pinot Noir, a superb vintage, traditional method, a touch of yeast, notes of raspberry and dry strawberry, with subtle savoury undertones. This wine is aged on the lees for a minimum of 32 months prior to disgorgement.

### 9. Bacchus ~ England

Often referred to as England's Sauvignon Blanc, this is a fragrant wine with aromas of ripe green apple and gooseberry with a hint of spice on the finish. Similar to N.Z Sauvignon - only better.
